

SUSTAINABILITY RAW MATERIALS

CERTIFIED ALPACA

Through the sourcing of certified alpaca, Saint Laurent supports alpaca production practices that ensure better ecosystem health and soil quality, efficient water use at farm and scouring levels, reduced chemical inputs and higher animal welfare standards than conventional practices.

CERTIFIED MOHAIR

Through the sourcing of certified mohair, Saint Laurent supports mohair production practices that ensure better ecosystem health and soil quality, efficient water use at farm and scouring levels, reduced chemical inputs and higher animal welfare standards than conventional practices.

CERTIFIED LINEN

Our certified linen guarantees the European origin of the linen fiber as well as higher environmental, social and economic standards than conventional production practices.

RECYCLED FIBERS

Following a circularity approach, Saint Laurent uses recycled fibers. This drastically reduces the environmental footprint as it avoids the impacts related to virgin materials production and demands overall fewer resources to manufacture than conventional fibers.

REGENERATED LEATHER FIBERS

Crafted from high-quality resources leftover from previous collections, the regenerated leather fibers reflect Saint Laurent's commitment to sustainability and innovation.

CERTIFIED ACETATE

Our certified acetate is made with a majority of fibers coming from more responsibly managed forests compared to conventional forestry practices and/or recycled fibers. This guarantees a better management of the forests and avoids destructive forestry practices such as illegal logging, natural forest conversion to other land uses, liquidation of high conservation value forests, civil rights violations, and genetic modification of forest species standards.

CERTIFIED CUPRO

Our certified cupro is made with recycled cellulosic fiber. This avoids consuming new resources by reusing cotton fibers coming from manufacturing scraps and enables to significantly reduce the environmental footprint compared to virgin fibers.

CERTIFIED MODAL

Our certified modal is made with a majority of fibers from more responsibly managed forests compared to conventional forestry practices and/or recycled fibers. This guarantees a better management of the forests and avoids destructive forestry practices such as illegal logging, natural forest conversion to other land uses, liquidation of high conservation value forests, civil rights violations, and genetic modification of forest species standards.
